
ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

This document details the steps taken by Rhinoceros staff to protect the environment. This Policy statement covers all activities on any Rhinoceros site. This policy applies to a Rhinoceros sites..

The Directors of Rhinoceros Ltd will work towards improving our environmental performance and, where practicable, to prevent pollution at source, taking into consideration business objectives, main contractor or client requirements, employees and the local community. The Directors are committed to meeting or surpassing current environmental legislation and regulations, reducing or re-cycling all waste and packing resulting from our activities.

The following steps will be taken by all Rhinoceros operatives to eliminate or reduce the impact of our works on the environment:

1. Where possible paint will be applied by brush and roller rather than by spraying. This reduces the volume of VOCs released into the atmosphere.
2. Where practicable paint removal will be carried out using paint disbonder with low VOC content.
4. Paints and solvents will be disposed of safely.
5. Drip trays and spill containment will be used to prevent the spillage of diesel, petroleum or oils.
6. Where practicable full containment will be provided for blast cleaning and paint spraying works.
7. Rhinoceros sites will be kept clean and tidy.
8. All waste will be disposed of properly using approved waste disposal facilities and contractors.
9. Paper, cardboard, timber, steel and other materials will be recycled and not sent to landfill.
10. In pricing and estimating care and protection of the environment is a key factor in selecting methods and materials.
11. Environmental benefits are assessed in selecting and approving suppliers
